

RULES

1. The only objects that are valid to transform, use as payment, or fulfill requests at the River are those you receive from one of the vendors there; you cannot modify or break up objects yourself. When you receive an object from a vendor, they will tell you its name. (You may also ask the Explorer to identify any object whose name you may have forgotten.)
2. The output of a transformation will always be a singular, uncapitalized, unabbreviated English noun. An object is always something you can carry or write down- it is never a person.
3. The vendors may make requests for different objects- if they do, they'll give you a card describing what they want. When you give them the object, give them the card as well.
4. You may ask any vendor if a transformation would be valid if you show them the object(s) required to perform it. Similarly, you may ask if they would accept an object to fulfill a request or serve as payment if you show it to them. The vendors will not comment on hypotheticals concerning objects you don't have.
5. You may ask a vendor to repeat the description of any transformation they've told you about, or a request whose card you have.
6. You may undo any transformation you performed by giving the output of the transformation back to the vendor who performed it. They will give you the object(s) you gave them to initiate the transformation.
7. You cannot undo turning in an object that fulfills a vendor's request, and you will never be in a situation where you need to.

RULE

1. Yes, the RULES are an object that can be transformed in the system.
